The HANDS Foundation is most known for our Senior Wish Program. Funds are made available by grant application to seniors and their families for special needs they could not otherwise afford or obtain through any other resource. This program fills a huge void in services to seniors and no other organization has a program like Senior Wishes.

Aside from our Senior Wish Program we also have our Helping HANDS Newspaper. Helping HANDS is a 32 page, bi-monthly newspaper that is directly mailed free of charge to 11,000 Medina County seniors, family members, and community leaders 6 times per year. The paper contains educational, informational, and entertaining articles geared towards seniors and their specific issues and topics of interest. There is no other publication like it in Medina County and our feedback from readers has always been very positive. This publication is supported solely through advertising revenue.
